Treasurer's Report:

Election of 2016 Master Association officers:

Art Fleet reported on voting results. There was a tie in Adam Brown and Summerwood; both neighborhoods will have runoff elections with the incumbent to remain in office until votes are counted on January 29. Subject to that, new directors are Eugene Szymborksi (CCV), Jim Baxter (IG), and Peter Northcott (KD/HP). Art Fleet welcomed the new directors.

There were no other nominations and Art Fleet was elected 2016 President.

Art Fleet nominated Lindsay Mardick Vice President Second: Bobby Boyd

There were no other nominations and Lindsay Mardick was elected 2016 Vice President.

Sallie Cox nominated Bobby Boyd for Treasurer Second: Lindsay Mardick

There were no other nominations and Bobby Boyd was elected 2016 Treasurer.

Art Fleet nominated Sallie Cox for Secretary Second: Lindsay Mardick
There were no other nominations and Sallie Cox was elected 2016 Secretary.

Art Fleet discussed a monthly Inverness planning calendar being instituted for planning and scheduling purposes. It is anticipated the planning calendar will be very helpful.

Web Site - After discussion, the Board decided to proceed toward contracting with Josh Reams of Great New Day to maintain the IMHA web site. The general plan will be to get the new web site up and running and then work on customization as appropriate for individual neighborhoods.

Board Training: Elbert Boothby has agreed to conduct a training session for board members who wish to attend, and has suggested a Monday evening. Designation of Neighborhood Presidents/Directors: Art Fleet indicated he plans to revert to referring to elected representatives as neighborhood presidents.

Late Fees/Violation Assessments: The board discussed how to handle assessments that are paid but the underlying issue is not corrected, and how late fees are/are not being applied, and what minimum balance may be required to activate accumulation of the \$15 monthly late fee. A consistent policy needs to be developed.
